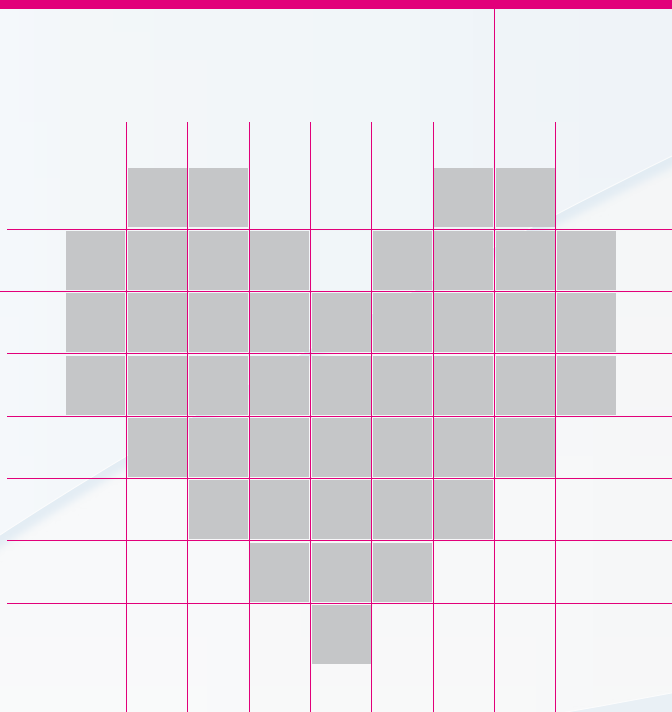

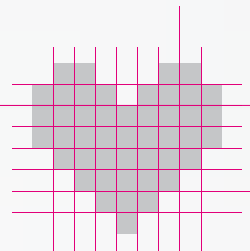
**The Congress has applied for CME accreditation by the Italian Ministry of Health, UEMS and EBAC.**
